Son of Renowned Paul-Son Dice and Chip Maker Paul Endy Jr. Featured at Annual Casino Collectibles Show

Author of new book on the gaming *industry's* most influential casino products company, Paul-Son Gaming Supplies, on hand at the *world's* largest casino memorabilia show June 15 in Las Vegas

LAS VEGAS (April 10, 2023) — For half a century the innovations of Paul-Son Gaming Supplies

helped pave the way to casino growth worldwide. The company whose name became synonymous with casino chips and dice is the subject of a new book by company founder Paul Endy's son, Eric. The author will greet attendees at the Casino Collectibles Association's 30th annual casino chip and collectibles show, the world's largest show of casino collector's items. The annual extravaganza is open to the public at the South Point Hotel and Casino June 15 -17 in Las Vegas.


Anyone familiar with the gaming industry in Las Vegas — or the world for that matter — will recognize the legendary Paul-Son company name.

It was founded in 1963 by Paul S. Endy Jr. and run by him and his sons for some of the most dynamic decades in the growth of the gaming industry. A 1997 inductee into the Nevada Gaming Hall of Fame, Paul Endy's innovations revolutionized the industry with top-quality playing cards, gaming tables, roulette wheels, cellulose acetate dice, security-enhanced poker chips and improved graphics applications. With over 40 years of experience, he was personal friends with most of the celebrated names in the casino industry, and his pioneering company helped them fuel the casino boom of the 1990s.





His third and youngest son, Eric P. Endy, MBA, is the author of a new book that shares the story of his father's life and his legacy to the gaming industry. Endy is happy to share his stories of the company, casino customers and historical gaming figures at the Casino Collectibles Association's 30th annual show. "My father brought legitimacy to the gaming supply industry," Endy says. "He developed new technology like microfilm in gaming chips to help prevent forgeries and the proprietary molding system that allowed us to use highly detailed color graphics on chips." Eric Endy will greet those attending the

World's Largest Casino Chip and Collectibles Show on day one from 2 PM to 4 PM on Thursday, June 15th at the South Point Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas. The show runs Thursday, Friday and Saturday, June 15 -17, 2023.

The World's Largest Casino Chip and Collectibles Show is open to the public and offers the greatest collection of casino memorabilia, souvenirs and keepsakes ever assembled in a single location. Over 50 worldwide dealers will be on hand to offer attendees the unique opportunity to examine, buy, sell, or trade casino collectibles.
