Movie Star, Comedian, Singer, Dancer, and Vegas Entertainment Legend Nelson Sardelli To Greet Attendees at Annual Casino Collectibles Show

With starring roles with Jayne Mansfield, Mae West and Judy Garland, Sardelli brings his hilarious stories to the *world's* largest casino memorabilia show



LAS VEGAS (April 24, 2023) — Brazilian-born of Italian descent, Nelson Sardelli brought his rakish good looks, golden voice, and humorous charms in the 1960's and 70's to his opening act in the showrooms and as a headliner in the lounges of famous Las Vegas Strip hotels including the Sahara, Riviera, Thunderbird, Tropicana, and Flamingo. Sardelli's many talents landed him romantic leading roles in films including Myra Breckinridge, The Professionals and Fake Out, along with friendships with leading ladies like Jayne Mansfield, Judy Garland, Mae West and Pia Zadora. "Not everyone becomes a major star, but the people at my level are the backbone of show business because we are the ones who are everywhere," Sardelli is fond of saying.



A famed humanitarian, his fund-raiser event for mentally

disabled children, "Starshine", gathers fellow performers and community leaders to shine shoes for a great cause throughout the U.S. and some of the countries where Sardelli has performed. A veteran himself, Sardelli regularly donates his time and talents to many veteran's events. He lives by his mantra, "Nobody is taller than when they lean down to help somebody else".



Sardelli has performed from Carnegie Hall to the Sydney (Australia) Opera House and was awarded the Golden Pillow Award from the International Entertainer School of Las Vegas and inducted into the Las Vegas Casino Legends Hall of Fame. He recently received the Koep Dean's Medal from the College of Fine Arts Hall of Fame at UNLV.

In many ways, Nelson Sardelli is one of a kind. He doesn't J-walk, spit on the sidewalk and has an advanced degree in military profanity.

Nelson Sardelli will greet those attending the World's Largest Casino Chip and Collectibles Show on day two from 10 AM to Noon on Friday, June 16, at the South Point Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas. The show runs three day, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, June 15 -17, 2023.
